NIGHTCLUB AT KINGS CROSS

Dear Bank goers,

As part of our commitment to ensuring all our patrons have a quality experience at the venue, we will be making some changes to our door policy.

Commencing on Friday 17th September, we may be denying entry to anybody that fails to meet the following criteria:

- **Dress code:** No singlets, baggy t-shirts, hoodies, shorts, athletic or training wear, cargos, open shoes, sports shoes, Ed Hardy, caps, beanies, any clothing with offensive or crude writing/imagery, any clothing that is believed to be related to any groups representing crime.

- **Haircut policy:** No rats tails, mullets, excessive Mohawks, stripes, patterns or offensive haircuts

- **Tattoos:** any large or excessive tattoos may result in being denied entry. Please attempt to cover them up.

- **Large groups of males:** We may deny entry to large groups of males if you are perceived to be potentially aggressive or violent

- All patrons will be scanned on entry with a hand held metal detector and may have their pockets/bags searched

- **No liquids,** bottles, drugs, medication or dangerous items will be permitted inside.

- **Young groups** of patrons may be denied entry if it is suspected that members may be underage
- Any persons believed to be intoxicated or under the influence of illicit medication/drugs may be refused entry
  
- **Bad attitude:** anybody who is rude, aggressive, violent, loud, quarrelsome, difficult or is perceived to have a negative effect on patrons inside will be denied entry

Entry is completely at the discretion of door staff and management. In line with the Enclosed Lands Act (1943), approved staff has the right to refuse entry to any persons without the provision of a reason.

We remind you that under the above-mentioned act, it is an offence to fail to leave the premises after being asked. If you fail to leave, we will contact the Police. Security personnel to have the right to apprehend and restrain any offenders until Police arrive, at which time you will be issued with an 'on the spot' fine starting at \$550 and maximising at \$5500. You may also be legally banned from entering Kings Cross from anywhere between 6 hours and 12 months. Failure to comply with these conditions may result in the offender being arrested and charged. **Following last weekend's events we will engage in this legal process should you fail to comply with our door policy.** A reminder that both our door and the neighbouring area is under 24 hour CCTV audio-visual surveillance, and any recordings may be used as evidence against you.
